FALL PUMPKIN ANIMALS

Believe it or not, it's not hard to make these adorable creatures. Gather leaves, acorns, nuts and sunflower seeds to transform pumpkins into your not-so-furry friends. Keep them for yourself, or as decorations for your Halloween or Thanksgiving table!

Here is what you'll need:

- Pumpkins (various sizes)
- Paint & paint brushes (optional)
- Leaves, acorns, sticks, seeds, etc.
 Hot glue gun (and a grown up)

Directions:

- 1. Pick your pumpkins. Look for pumpkins that have the features of the animal you're making. For example, is your animal big or small? Does it have a round face or a long one? Is its nose pointy or short? Find pumpkins that have these same features to help your animal come to life.
- 2. If you want it to be a different color, paint them and let them dry completely. (Hint: Acrylic paint works best on pumpkins)
- 3. Use the hot glue gun to attach the leaves, acorns, sticks, seeds, or anything else you gathered to make your animal.
- 4. Once everything is dry, set them in your favorite spot and enjoy!

FALL STORY ROCKS!

Create magical story stones that help you build your own fall adventures and spooky tales!

What You'll Need:

- Smooth, flat rocks (or small pebbles)
- Paint or permanent markers
- Clear tape or a sealant spray (optional)

How To Make Your Story Rocks:

- 1. Find Your Rocks Collect some smooth rocks from outside or use ones from a craft store.
- 2. Pick Your Fall Themes Think of fun fall images to draw on your rocks like pumpkins, leaves, owls, witches, ghosts, apples, scarves, or acorns.
- 3. Draw or Paint Your Designs Use markers or paint to decorate each rock with one image. Keep it simple or add fun details!
- 4. Seal Your Art (optional) If you want your rocks to last, cover them with clear tape or spray with a sealant (ask an adult for help).

How to Play: Mix up your story rocks in a bag or bowl. Pull out 3–5 rocks at a time. Use the pictures to tell a fun fall story out loud! Swap rocks with friends or family and create new stories together.

FALL FUN: GLOW-IN-THE-DARK PUMPKIN HUNT!

Get ready for a spooky, glowing adventure right in your backyard or inside your house! Find all the hidden glowing pumpkins or glow sticks before time runs out!

What You'll Need:



Mini pumpkins and glow sticks



A flashlight or two



A grown-up or friend to set up



A timer (optional)

How To Play:

1. Gather Your Glow Items

Find mini pumpkins (real or fake) and attached a glow stick to each one to make it easy to spot in the dark.

2. Choose Your Hunting Spot

Pick a safe outdoor area like your yard, garden, or a room inside the house with the lights off or dimmed.

3. Hide the Glow Items

Before dark, ask your parents or a friend to hide the mini pumpkins with the glow sticks attached around your chosen spot.

4. Get Your Flashlight Ready

When it's dark enough, grab your flashlight and get ready to hunt. You could also race a friend or family member to see who finds the most in the fastest time!

5. Start the Hunt!

Use your flashlight to spot the glowing pumpkins. Just be careful and watch your step!

6. Count Your Treasures

Once you've found them all, count how many you collected. You could even get a prize for the person who finds the most items or who finds them in the fastest time.

Want to play again? This time you can do the hiding. Mix up the hiding spots and see how fast your parents or friends can find them.
