DIY UPCYCLED LUGGAGE TAGS

Going on a summer vacation? Add these customized DIY upcycled luggage tags to your suitcases.

Below is what you'll need. Look around your house before you buy new supplies. Get creative and limit your waste!

- Cardstock
- Ribbon or Twine
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- (Optional) Lamination sheets or packaging tape



To make the tags:

- Cut 2 pieces of cardstock to roughly 3 x 2 inches.
- Glue the ribbon or twine between two pieces of cardstock and let dry.
- Decorate the tag.
- (Optional) To make your tag last longer, laminate the tag or wrap it in packaging tape.

HOW TO MAKE SAVING MONEY A HABIT

One of the best banking habits you can start doing now is learning how to save money every time you get some.

It can be a hard thing to do. It's tempting and easy to spend all the money you get on fun things. But, if you never save any of the money you get, you might not have enough money to buy things you need later on.

Instead, if you can make a habit of saving just a few dollars every time you get money, it will keep the balance in your savings account growing. That way when you need money, it will already be in your account.

HOW TO GET STARTED

To start, try to deposit a small amount of the money you receive into your savings account, or into your piggy bank until you can take it to the bank.

For example, let's say you get \$10 on your birthday. Instead of spending it all, put \$2 in your piggy bank (to deposit into your savings account later), and then you can spend the \$8 that is leftover on something fun! If you do this every time you get money, you'll watch your savings account balance get bigger and bigger.

- The last person to get tagged wins! Then you can restart the game with a new "it" person.



When you get an itch to go camping but can't go far, look no further than your (or a friend's) backyard!



Here are some fun ideas and tips:

While the standard s'more is always tasty, swapping out a few ingredients can turn the traditional s'more we all know and love into something even more mouthwateringly delicious!




