## DIY 3-D LADYBUG CRAFT

Get crafty and make these adorable 3-D ladybugs!

- Construction Paper - red, black and just a little bit of white
- Scissors
- Stick glue
- Black marker


## Directions:

1. Cut a circle shape and strips out of red paper.
2. Glue the ends of one strip of paper onto the base (as shown). Glue on the next one at a $90^{\circ}$ angle to the first one
3. Continue adding strips until the body of the ladybug is full.
4. Cut dots, a head and two antenna out of black paper.
5. Cut two small oval shapes out of white paper and draw the eyes with black marker.
6. Glue on the dots and head with the stick glue.
