GIVE BANK

In January's Newsletter, Friendly taught you how to use four different banks to keep track of your money. In this newsletter, he wants to focus on the "Give" bank. This bank is used to give money back to your community. A suggested "rule of thumb" is to give 10% of your income to your favorite charity, church, foundation, etc.

Let's do some simple math to see how much you should donate.

If you make \$150 a week and you donate 10%, how much will you donate?

\$150 x .10 = _____

Answer: 15

RICE KRISPIE EARTH RECIPE

1/4 cup margarine
1/2 tsp. vanilla
green and blue food coloring

40 regular marshmallows
6 cups rice krispies

- Melt margarine and marshmallows over medium heat in a large pot, stir in vanilla and rice krispies.
- Divide into two bowls, and add green food coloring to one bowl and blue food coloring to the second. Stir each separately until combined.
- Take a scoop from the blue bowl and a scoop from the green bowl and mash them together in a ball (to make the earth). Then set aside until completely cool.
