HOW BANKS WORK

Have you ever wondered how a bank works? Or what happens to your money after you deposit it into your account? Basically, a bank uses the money people have in their accounts and lends it out to people who want to buy big things, like a car or house, when they don't have enough money. The people who borrow money have to pay it back plus a little extra (called interest), and then the bank pays you interest for letting them use the money in your account. Here is an example:



#1: You deposit \$10 into your savings account.

Why should you deposit money into your account instead of keeping it at home?



#2: The bank lends your \$10 to someone who wants to buy a bike but doesn't have enough money saved up.

Why would they do this? Well, the bank expects the borrower (the person who asked for the money) to pay back the money plus a little extra (called interest). That's how a bank makes money!



#4: The bank pays you \$1 in interest for letting them use your money to lend out.

This money gets deposited right into your account, so just by leaving your savings account alone you can earn extra money!



#3: The borrower pays the bank back \$12 (the original \$10 they asked for plus \$2 interest).



What happened to the other \$1 the bank got from the borrower? They paid the bank \$2 in interest and the bank gave you \$1. Well, the bank will use that \$1 to help pay the people who work at the bank, or other bills, like electricity or heat for the building, etc.

MONSTER JIGGLERS

2 ½ cups boiling water, divided
¼ cup grape flavored gelatin
1 (3 oz.) package lime flavored gelatin

Spray insides of 24 - 1 oz. plastic glasses with cooking spray; set aside. Add 1 ½ cups boiling water to lime gelatin mix in a medium bowl. Stir 2 minutes until completely dissolved. Chill 12-15 minutes or until cool but not set.

Meanwhile, add remaining ½ cup boiling water to grape gelatin mix in small bowl; stir 2 minutes until completely dissolved. Spoon about 1 ¼ tsp. into each 1 oz. glass; set aside.

Spoon chilled lime gelatin over partially set grape gelatin. Refrigerate 3 hours or until firm. Unmold desserts onto tray just before serving. Insert licorice into each side for "bolts" and decorate face with decorating gel. Serve immediately.

32 pieces red string licorice, cut ½ inch each
1 (1.5 ounce) tube black decorating gel
